It has never been easier to respond to the census from the comfort and safety of your own home.

If you have not yet completed your census questionnaire, please do so now using one of the following options:

- **ONLINE** – Visit 2020census.gov
- **PHONE** – Call 844-330-2020
- **MAIL** – Questionnaires were mailed to homes in April

Be sure to count everyone living in your home as of April 1, 2020. All census responses are confidential and protected by law.

Your response will impact the future of your community. The results of the 2020 Census will guide the distribution of more than \$675 billion in federal funding annually to local communities for roads, schools, housing, health centers and more.

Census Takers in Your Neighborhood

Starting in early August, census takers will visit homes that haven't yet responded to the 2020 Census.

Census takers are hired from your area, and their goal is to help you and everyone in your home be counted in the 2020 Census. If the census taker who visits your home does not speak your language, you may request a return visit from a census taker who does speak your language.



Census takers will wear masks and follow local public health guidelines when they visit your home. All census takers complete a virtual COVID-19 training on social distancing and other health and safety protocols before beginning their work in neighborhoods.

If no one is home when the census taker visits, the census taker will leave a notice of their visit with information about how to respond online, by phone or by mail.

How to verify that someone is a census taker

If someone visits your home to collect information for the 2020 Census, check to make sure they have a valid ID badge with their photograph, a U.S. Department of Commerce watermark, and an expiration date. Census workers may also carry Census Bureau bags and other equipment with the Census Bureau logo.

If you respond online or by phone today, a census taker is less likely to have to visit your home to collect your response.
